Visa application for an internship stay

Unpaid internships up to max. 90 days

German citizens and passport holders from other <u>countries and regions</u> can enter the country without a visa. All other persons apply for a <u>temporary visa</u>.

Unpaid internships over 90 days ("Cultural Activity Visa")

A visa is required. The responsible party at the place of internship must first apply for a Certificate of Eligibility CoE. The visa can then be issued at the embassy or consulate general. For further information see HERE.

Paid internships ("Designated Activity Visa")

A visa is required regardless of the length of stay. The responsible party at the place of internship must first apply for a Certificate of Eligibility CoE. The visa can then be issued at the embassy or consulate general. For further information see HERE.
