Visa for JSPS and MEXT scholarships

1. JSPS Scholarship

In principle, JSPS scholarship holders always require a visa, regardless of the duration of their stay. Please apply at the <u>consulate or embassy responsible for your place of residence</u>.

Required documents:

- Passport (original and copy)
- Non-Germans and non-EU citizens: valid residence permit for Germany
- <u>Visa application form</u> with passport photo

Citizens from CIS countries, Georgia and Ukraine please submit 2 application forms and 2 passport photos

- Certificate of Eligibility CoE from Japan*
- JSPS Letter of Award
- JSPS Certificate of Financial Support

2. MEXT Scholarship

Once you have been accepted for a MEXT scholarship, please contact the <u>consulate or embassy</u> <u>responsible for your place of residence.</u> The consulates/embassy will usually receive an official notification and list of names of all MEXT scholarship holders in a timely manner. When applying for a visa, please be sure to mention that you have a MEXT scholarship!

Required documents:

- Passport (original and copy)
- Non-Germans and non-EU citizens: valid residence permit for Germany
- Visa application form with passport photo

Citizens from CIS countries, Georgia and Ukraine please submit 2 application forms and 2 passport photos

^{*} The CoE must be applied for by the hosting institute in Japan, please inform them about it in due time (see also here). If a CoE can not be presented, it is still possible to apply for the visa, however, processing takes significantly longer than usual (several weeks)!
